# **Have a Great Audition!**

### **Research the Requirements**

Every production posts a segment that asks what they would like to see. Sometimes they ask for a song of your choice, other times they ask for a song from the show. Sometimes they ask for 16 bars instead of 32. Be sure to put your best foot forward by preparing what the production team asks for!

## Song & Monologue Selection

Pick song selections that best showcase you as a performer and your range. You also want to be smart about what style the show is. You wouldn't want to sing a contemporary rock ballad for *The Sound of Music!* 

### **Dress to Impress!**

An audition is like an interview: this is the first time the production team is meeting you, so dress to show your personality and professionalism!

### **Practice Slating (Introducing yourself)**

Be sure to practice slating before you start your audition. State your name, the title of the song, and the show it is from. Same goes for your monologue.

#### **HAVE FUN!**

View your audition as a performance, and enjoy it! Make those character choices, and show you are ready to dive into two weeks of theater!
